Registration is now open for the 46th Society of University Neurosurgeons meeting in Atlanta, Georgia on March 18-21, 2012.

REGISTRATION

The SUN 2012 registration fee is \$950 and covers the participant and any accompanying guests. The registration deadline has been extended to February 3, 2012. For participants, the registration fee includes attendance to all meetings, all meals, the opening reception and closing night gala, and planned activities at Burge Plantation and the Georgia Aquarium. Accompanying guests will also enjoy the opening reception and gala, meals, and planned activities at Burge Plantation and the Georgia Aquarium.

FLIGHT PLANNING / TRANSPORTATION

For travel planning purposes, please note that the program begins on Sunday, March 18 with a reception at 6:30pm. The program concludes after lunch on Wednesday, March 21. With this in mind, we advise that flights on Wednesday be scheduled after 3:30 pm.

Airport ground transportation to and from the hotel will not be provided by the meeting organizers. We ask that you make these arrangements on your own. Taxis are readily available, or you may contact the hotel concierge (1-404-881-9898) to make other arrangements. The Atlanta airport code is ATL.

HOTEL
